

FAQ MOT Questions Re: MSOT free Student Membership

Q: Why are there no fees for students?

A: We offer students free membership during their OT academic program to encourage their professional development and in the hopes that, having seen the value MSOT offers, they will become full members upon their graduation.

Q: What does the student membership include?

A: MOT students are eligible to receive email blasts from the MSOT Office with information regarding employment opportunities, MSOT newsletter editions and other OT news-related items.

Q: What does my MSOT Student membership NOT include?

A: The MSOT student membership *does not* include a username nor access to the member portal on the MSOT website as these benefits are reserved for full members only.

Q: How do I become an MSOT Student Member?

A: Provide your email to your MSOT class rep. The MSOT class rep will put all names and email addresses in an Excel document and provide to Sandra Nowicki.

Q: When does my student membership expire?

A: June 30 of your year of graduation.

Q: When/how can I become a full MSOT member?

Once you graduate, you can sign up with MSOT as a New Grad Member (for \$50.00) and receive full member benefits (including access to the Member Portal). Forms can be mailed (120 Maryland St, Winnipeg, MB R3G 1L1) or e-mailed to the office at msot@msot.mb.ca. Payment can be made by credit card (in person or over the phone) or a cheque can be mailed into the office. Call in before the end of June. After the New Grad Member year, the membership fee is \$100 per year and registration can occur in conjunction with COTM renewal.

MSOT (Manitoba Society of Occupational Therapists) is the member association. You **do not** need to be working to become a member of MSOT - you can join MSOT at any time!
