2. Press "Ctrl + F" and type the issue or support you are seeking help for. A box will appear on the top right corner. Type your search term and then use the arrows (up or down) to scroll through the document and find OTs that provide service for that area.
3. Open "Bookmark" icon (). Click on the Bookmark link to go directly to that page.
