Description and Criteria

Award Description

MSOT supports and encourages members to give back to the community through charitable actions. This award celebrates one MSOT member each year that participates in the most Team OT events or contributes a lot of time and energy to supporting a Team OT event in Manitoba.

The award is a certificate of acknowledgement and appreciation. There is no monetary value to this award.

Criteria for selection of the MSOT Professional Development Award

This award will be presented annually in the spring at the OT Celebration Night. The MSOT Board of Directors will vote on MVP based on the criteria described below.

Specific Criteria:

- Must be an MSOT member (including students) in good standing
- Must have participated in more than one Team OT event and preferably most of the Team OT events during the membership year (June 1 May 31)
- Preference will be given to a member that has been a captain and organized volunteer members for at least one event
